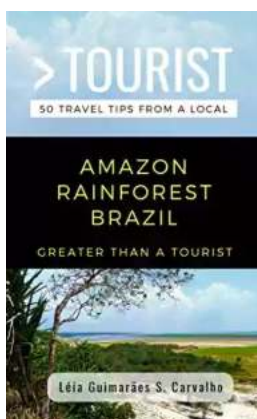

<p><b>9</b> Tudo bem?</p> <p>Literally translating to 'Everything well?', it is the most common way to ask 'how are you?'.</p> 	<p><b>10</b> Legal/Beleza</p> <p>Cool, sounds good!</p>
