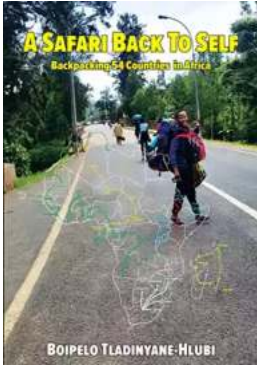

This is a vivid, authentic story and an invitation to take that journey across Africa. There's no better companion than Boipelo's story of her journey across the continent.



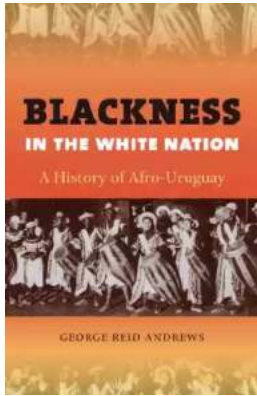
