FIGURE 2-52 Valley Flashing for Shakes and Shingles.

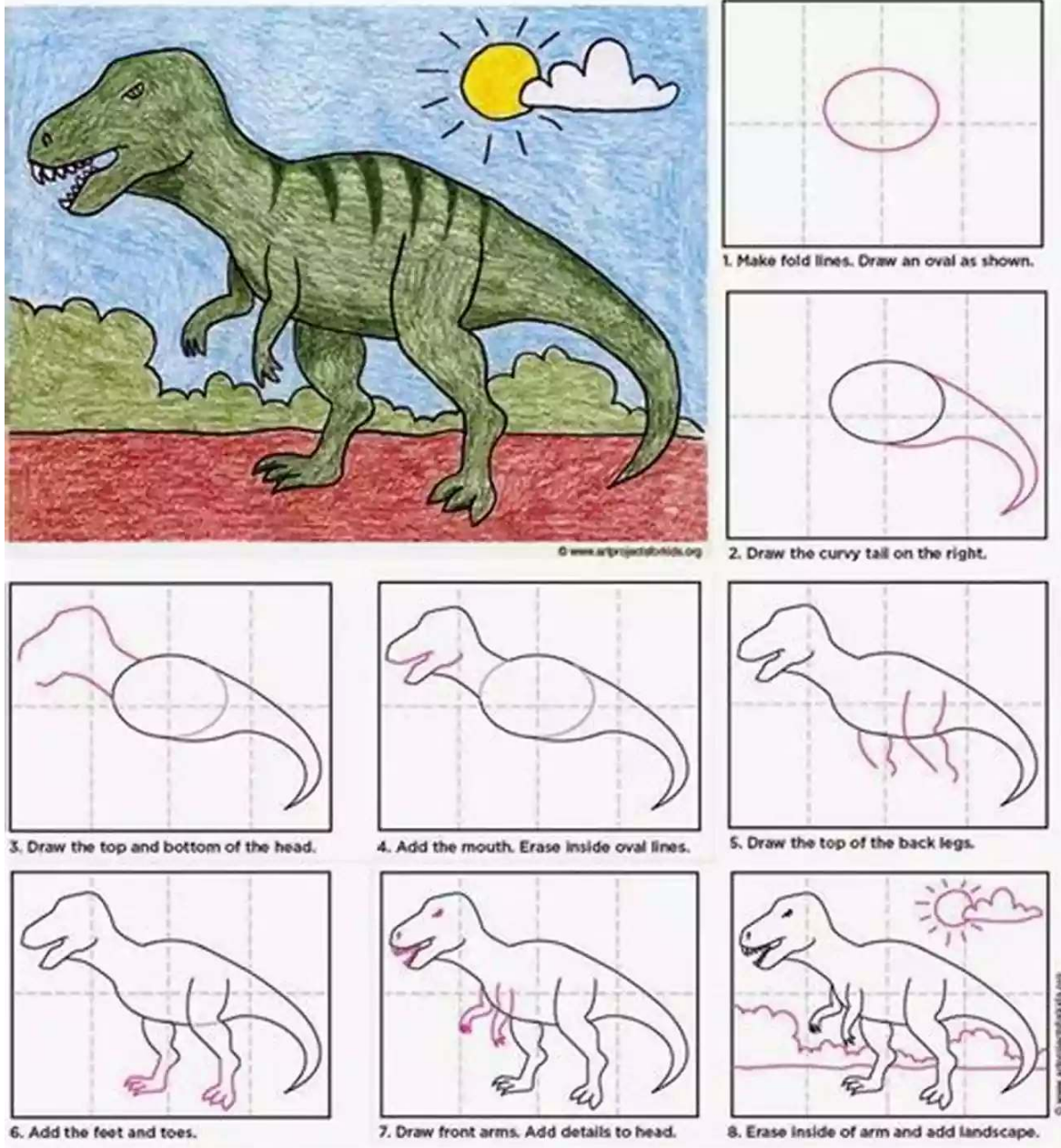
