His life was composed of career successes juxtaposed with family tragedies, but above all, my grandfather was an entrepreneur for religious freedom. In telling his story I hope to support the ideal of religious freedom that shaped our country through tying together the creation of the Lutheran Free Church, the importance of family relationships, and the ways in which our country was shaped by the wave of immigration in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries. The book also includes my History of

the Lutheran Free Church. My grandfather was a joyous person, full of energy and determination to make the best of what life dealt him. These letters are intended as a tribute to his strong work ethic and generosity of spirit.



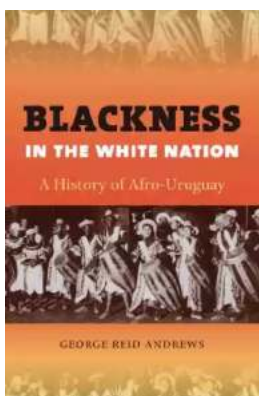
