

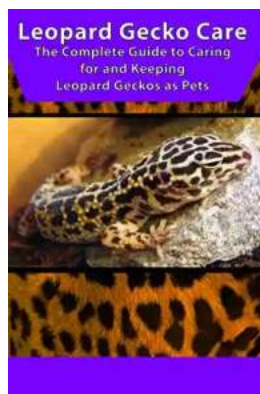

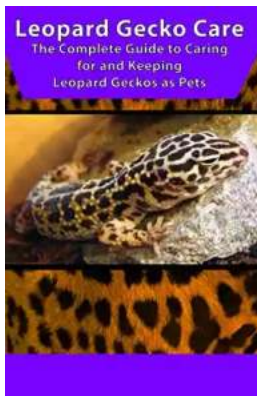

The name *Macularius* is derived from the Latin word *Macula* which translates to 'spot' or 'blemish' which is in obvious reference to the animal's spotted markings. They are naturally found in the deserts of Asia, Pakistan and northern India.

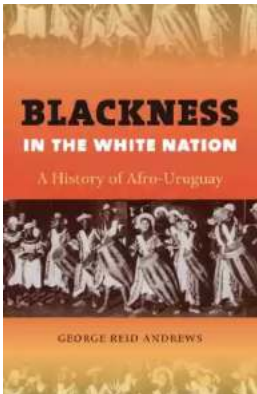

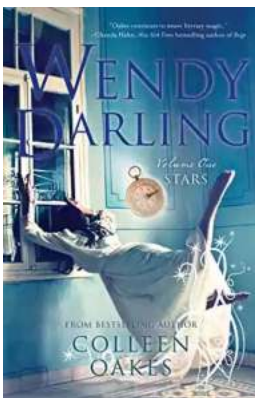
