- **Set:** A set consists of three or four cards of the same rank.
- **Run:** A run consists of three or more consecutive cards of the same suit.
- **Deadwood:** Unmatched cards in your hand are referred to as deadwood.

If the knocking player has a deadwood count of zero (Gin), they earn a higher bonus. The game is played over several hands, and the first player to reach a predetermined score, usually 100 or 250 points, is declared the winner.
