





Thomas Jefferson is known by most as the third president of the United States, but his legacy extends much further than that. 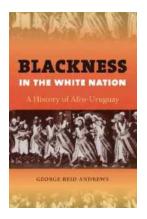

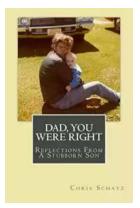

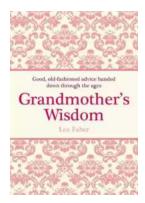
